Guidelines for Portfolio Book Report

Each Semester you will be required to submit a book report in essay form. You will then submit the report to your writing teacher as one of your writing assignments.

First, choose a book that you want to give the report on. It can be a book you've already read or a new one. **Second,** write a rough draft. Hand your rough draft in to me by week 10. Your rough draft can be handwritten or typed. Always, **double space** your rough draft as it is easier for me to make corrections. Your final draft can be either single spaced or double spaced. **Third,** I will proofread and make corrections to your rough draft and give it back to you. **Fourth,** rewrite your rough draft and resubmit it to me as a final draft. Then, give it to me to okay and sign. Your final draft must be typed. Remember the **title of the book** should always be *italicized* or <u>underlined</u>. **Fifth,** hand it in to your writing teacher by week 12.

Your book report should begin with an introductory paragraph. This paragraph should introduce the book. That is, tell what it is about, who the main characters are and who the author is. The body of the book report should be one or two paragraphs long. In this part you should summarize the story. The last paragraph should be your conclusion. In the conclusion, you should say what you liked or didn't like about the book.

The above sentences are single spaced. Below is an example of double spacing and an italicized title. Notice that the first line is indented.
