- All presentations will be evaluated by the class. Grades for presentations will be based on the teacher's and the class's evaluations.
- All groups must submit a presentation outline that includes the following information:
 - 1 Title of Presentation
 - 2 Names of group members, roles (project leader, researcher, presenter, etc.) and research contribution
 - 3 Outline of the presentation
 - 4 List of sources MLA (8th edition format)
